

Individual to Individual Abuse: DOs and DON'Ts

The Purpose of the DOs and DON'Ts is assisting in team planning and effective corrective actions when addressing I2I Abuse

DOs

Corrective Actions / Team Planning (physical I2I)

- 1.) Team will look to establish a Root Cause (via team meeting, debriefing, etc)
 - other diagnosis or medical concerns
- 2.) Ask yourself do we need both a Victim/Target specific action
 - is follow up with victim and target needed?
- 3.) Planful, preventative steps taken to keep from re-occurring
- 4.) Review previous corrective actions
- 5.) Think about addressing environmental concerns
- 6.) Make sure to note when Victims may repeatedly expose themselves to a target
 - is it noted in the person's ISP/Plan of Support?

DON'Ts

Corrective Actions (Physical I2I)

- 1.) Assign staff that can't complete the action
- 2.) Don't use same corrective actions for repeat targets
- 3.) Don't use separation of target/victim as long term solution
- 4.) Don't write corrective actions that Victim may be unable to or cooperative with

Tips/Other:

- Document the completion of corrective actions
- How will you assess incident/target if report did not warrant a corrective action?
- What do you do when the root cause of the I2I is out of your control?
