Introduction: **Emily Corbin** is the eldest sister of Erica Shultz. After Erica's traumatic death, Emily was asked to speak at an *I AM Safe* meeting held for individuals who have intellectual disabilities in Bloomsburg. Emily soon became an active contributor to the *I AM Safe* group, which has helped her process some of her grief. This has also brought Emily closer to members of the community who knew and loved Erica, as well as highlighting the need for more resources in the community for cyber and individual safety.

Presenter: **Michelle Gwinn Nutter**, a Pennsylvania-certified teacher and former Safe and Supportive Schools Manager for the PA Center for Safe Schools, is an Education and Outreach Program Manager and Civil Rights Outreach Specialist. Michelle provides training and technical assistance for schools and community organizations. She is a nationally recognized speaker and frequently serves as a facilitator for the Student Problem Identification and Resolution of Issues Together (SPIRIT) Program coordinated by the U.S. Department of Justice's Community Relations Service. She is a certified Olweus Bullying Prevention Program trainer and a certified Partners Against Hate trainer. She assists schools in the prevention of and effective response to bullying, cyberbullying and bias-related tension incidents. Michelle received a B.A. Degree in English Education from Messiah College and a M.S. in Education Law. Michelle participated in the 2016 White House Bullying Prevention Summit and the 2016 Federal Bullying Prevention Summit.
